OBJECTIVES:

The student will be able to discuss and recognize a wide variety of hematologic problems.

The student will be introduced to the clinical evaluation and recognize indications for managing assorted hematologic problems.

The student may have the opportunity to perform bone marrow aspiration and biopsy.

The student will show efficiency in interpretation of blood smears.

DESCRIPTION:

This elective will evaluate and follow hospitalized patients with a variety of hematological problems. The student may have the opportunity for in-office experience evaluating new patients and in follow-up of hematological problems.

The student will attend seminars and conferences related to the problems of individual patients being seen, major blood diseases and associated affects of hematology.
