OBJECTIVES:

The Student Will Gain In-depth Experience In The Management Of Obstetrical Patients In Private Office Settings.

The Student Will Learn To Recognize High Risk And Complex Obstetrical Patients.

The Student Will Have Exposure To Common Gynecological Problems Both Surgical And Non-surgical.

The Student Will Gain Experience In The Total Care Of Postpartum Patients.

The Student Will Observe Specialized Ob/gyn Procedures, As Available.

DESCRIPTION:

This is a clinical experience in which the student will follow a specific preceptor in the private office and/or hospital clinic setting. Students have the opportunity to observe specialized Ob/Gyn procedures and to learn about private practice by working directly with an Ob/Gyn Practitioner. Students are encouraged to attend weekly Ob/Gyn lectures and seminars whenever possible.
