

## **Classifications For Volunteer Faculty**

### **Clinical Instructor/Resident**

This appointment is reserved for residents in an approved residency training program.

### **Clinical Instructor and Adjunct Instructor**

If a clinician, must possess a valid license. In general, this is the initial appointment for faculty receiving their first academic teaching appointment.

### **Clinical Assistant Professor and Adjunct Assistant Professor**

Board eligibility or certification is required for physicians. Valid license to practice in Michigan is required for clinicians. Quality teaching potential is a prime consideration at this level. This appointment requires at least **one** year of service as a Clinical/Adjunct Instructor.

### **Clinical Associate Professor or Adjunct Associate Professor**

Board certification is required for physicians. Valid license to practice in Michigan is required for clinicians. Prior appointment as a Clinical/Adjunct Assistant Professor for **five** years is expected. Individual should be recognized for scholarly and/or service contributions.

### **Clinical Professor or Adjunct Professor**

Board certification/Michigan license with distinguished academic productivity is required. Prior appointment as Clinical Associate Professor for at least **three** years, and approximately **ten** years participation in educational programs is expected. Candidates for consideration for this distinction must be recognized as authorities in their field at the state or national level.

**Please Note:** All applications for clinical faculty appointment are reviewed locally and subject to additional departmental requirements. Upon local approval, applications are reviewed by the Chairman of the Department at MSU, the Dean of the MSU College of Human Medicine, and then sent to the Board of Trustees for final approval.
